


How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?


NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

POST DATE TIMELINE FOR THIS MONTH'S ACTIVE JOB POSTINGS



How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?






DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR





What broad occupational category is being recruited?






Full-time vs Part-time
















